

**Common Core Academy
Summer 2012
Informational Summary**

The Common Core Academy for Summer 2012 will include the following content areas:

- ⤴ Mathematics grades K-5
- ⤴ Mathematics grades 7 & 8
- ⤴ Secondary Mathematics II
- ⤴ Social Studies (grade bands 6-8, 9-10, 11-12)
- ⤴ Science (Middle-level Science 6-8, Life Science, Physical Science)

The Academy will be held in fifteen (15) locations throughout the state.

The approximate boundaries of the Wasatch Front groups are as follows

- Wasatch Front North: Bountiful to Idaho
- Wasatch Front Central: Salt Lake to Point of the Mountain
- Wasatch Front South: Point of the Mountain to Santaquin

We will be working with districts to establish locations in the next two weeks. We are grateful for the support of the districts and schools who provide locations.

Please note that Social Studies and Science will be in five locations: Wasatch Central 1, St. George Regional, Vernal Regional, Cache Regional, and Wasatch North 2.

Registration Process

- ⤴ Registration will be required by individual teachers using the OnTrack system. Districts will not be able to register teams of teachers. Districts should work with the teachers they want to attend to encourage their early registration.
- ⤴ Registration will open for teachers in the seven (7) Regional locations on FEBRUARY 1, 2011. OnTrack will be monitored to ensure that the teachers registering between FEBRUARY 1 – FEBRUARY 15 are from the regional area. Those districts should encourage their teachers to register early in the window.
- ⤴ Registration will open for the state on FEBRUARY 16. All sessions and seats will be available after that date.

ELA Second Year Implementation

- ⤴ Ongoing support will be offered for LEAs via a Request for Proposal (RFP) process awarded to geographically created consortia.
- ⤴ Each consortia will prioritize their learning needs.
- ⤴ Consortia will design a program utilizing a variety of professional learning modules designed by state Core Academy facilitators and/or Writing Project Fellows.
- ⤴ Professional learning modules from which to choose may include the following:
 - Secondary Common Core Strands and Lesson Design
 - Secondary Common Core Writing
 - Elementary K-2 Common Core Strands and Lesson Design
 - Elementary 3-5 Common Core Strands and Lesson Design
 - Elementary K-2 Writing
 - Elementary 3-5 Writing
- ⤴ Consortia will provide co-facilitators to build capacity.
- ⤴ Consortia will arrange logistics (location, dates, etc.).
- ⤴ The RFP will be available no later than March 1, 2012.
