

## **HB 513 Early Intervention Software Program**

#### Reporting student data

As listed in the Assurances of the HB513 Early Intervention Software Program, this program is subject to evaluation by an external evaluation company to determine the level of implementation and the effect of the software intervention on student performance. The external evaluation will connect three data pools: (1) demographic data, which will come from USOE; DIBELS data, which will come from the districts or charter schools; and usage and performance data, which will come from software vendor.

#### Data from the computer-aided instructional software:

All students must log into the software using their unique LEA Student ID. This is the number your district has assigned to each student, the number the kids know and use as their lunch ID or that is printed on their school ID. They should not be logging in using a short name, a classroom number, or any other identifier other than this unique student ID unless you have assurances from the software provider that the student's log-in is both unique and linked to the LEA Student ID. This is the responsibility of the district/charter school to confirm.

This number will have the district identification number appended to it within the software so that it will serve as a unique identifier and correlate with the other two data pools described above.

If you have any questions about what the correct number is, please contact your district IT department. If you have any questions about the number or name that students at your site are using to log into the computer, please contact your software representative.

### **DIBELS data:**

The external evaluator will run a comparison of students' performance on the computer software with students' performance on the appropriate DIBELS assessments per grade level. At the end of the school year, each LEA will submit DIBELS data for participating schools/students to the USOE via a secure upload (Move-It). DIBELS data will include BOY, MOY, and EOY scores for each assessment. The Move-It information for upload will be sent to the 513 contact in the spring prior to the final administration of DIBELS and must be submitted by July 1, 2013. mClass users may upload data directly from mClass.

# Demographic data:

Demographic data will be submitted by the USOE based on the list of LEA Student IDs submitted by the software company and the LEAs.
