Utah eTranscript and Record Exchange (UTREx)

The Utah eTranscript and Record Exchange (UTREx) is a multi-component system that facilitates the electronic transfer of individual, detailed student records between LEAs and the USOE, between any two Utah public schools and allows electronic transcripts to be sent to any participating post-secondary institution.

UTREx Goals:

- Improved data quality through increased efficiency, more frequent submission, and the elimination of redundant data.
- Increased timeliness, accessibility, and integrity of student data.

UTREx Roll-out Schedule:

September, 2011	New infrastructure and processes for district/charter to USOE data submissions goes into use.
October, 2011	New infrastructure and processes used for first time to collect October 1 data.
November, 2011	SIF (School Interoperability Framework) technology becomes available as an option for district/charter to USOE data submissions. SSID assignment automation is available to all districts/charters.
December, 2011	Districts/charters are able to electronically send high school transcripts to post- secondary institutions; and electronically perform inter-district/charter school student-record transfers. This requires that district and charters use the SIF option.
September, 2013	All district and charters will be able to fully participate in UTREx via SIF.

Utah Data Alliance (UDA)

Utah Data Alliance Progress:

- Data Mapping of USOE, Utah System of Higher Education, Utah College of Applied Technology, and
 Utah Department of Workforce Services data for the Utah Data Alliance Data Share is being completed
 by the Utah Education Network.
- In addition, The Utah Department of Health, Utah Department of Human Services, and Utah
 Department of Corrections have expressed interest in sharing data with the Utah Data Alliance.
- Collaborative research efforts, coordinated by the Utah Education Policy Center are focused on early childhood, K-12, post-secondary education, and workforce pipeline and remediation study, achievement gaps, and educator effectiveness. The first Utah Data Alliance research reports will be completed in January 2012.
- The large-scale, permanent, Utah Data Alliance Data Share (UDADS) is in under development at Utah Education Network. Additional staff, as well as expert level contractors, is being engaged to expedite building this data warehouse.
