State Approved Endorsement Program (SAEP)

1. An approved SAEP for World Languages allows a Licensed Teacher to teach World Language classes while working on the World Language Endorsement in a specific language—meaning they are not yet highly qualified in a World Language.
2. The applicant has two years from the date the SAEP is approved to complete all requirements for the World Language Endorsement in the specific language of instruction.
3. The applicant must document a minimum of nine hours (level 3000 or higher) toward the endorsement or passing of appropriate Praxis II and/or Oral Language test *before* applying for the SAEP.

Submitting the Application

1. Print and complete this Endorsement Application.
2. The processing fee for each application is **\$45.00**.
3. Attach proof of passing the Praxis II Content Test and Oral Proficiency Test
4. Attach an official transcript for the Methods Course *with the relevant course highlighted*.
