PURPOSE AND MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Purpose

The Secondary Theatre Endorsement is for secondary teachers who are knowledgeable and skilled in theatre and desire to demonstrate and/or develop expertise in helping students develop the skills and understanding required in the Theatre Core Curriculum. Candidates will choose university courses, professional workshops, conferences, and activities as needed to qualify for the endorsement.

Requirements

- PRAXIS II Theatre Content Knowledge Test #0640 (Score 630)
- Theatre History and Dramaturgy (upper division)
- Acting (Upper Division)
- Playwriting and Playmaking
- Production (Design, Technical Theatre, Front of House)
- Stage Directing/Stage Management
- Secondary Theatre Teaching Methods
- Optional K-12 extension requirement: Elementary Theatre Teaching

Methods

To avoid taking classes that may not be accepted, first submit completed portfolio and endorsement application as per instructions above. Course availability of all courses changes, as well as procedures for being admitted into them. Here is a [directory](#) to our universities and colleges.
