A candidate for the Driver Education Endorsement must fulfill the following requirements (check appropriate box):

Complete an approved Utah institution of higher education program for the Driver Education Endorsement (specialized professional preparation consisting of 16 semester hours in the area of driver and safety education, including current certification for First Aid and CPR) **OR**

Complete coursework equivalent to an approved program to demonstrate competencies in:

- a. A minimum of 12 semester hours shall be in the area of driver and safety education, including a practicum* covering classroom and behind-the-wheel instruction (include simulator, driving range, and skid control car if possible), and
- b. A minimum of 3 semester hours shall be elected from areas of related safety work, health issues such as the risks of substance abuse, and principles and practices in emergency care, and
- c. First Aid and CPR training of 1 semester hour shall be current.

AND (Check all boxes)

A valid Utah driver license.

A satisfactory driving record, which will be interpreted to consist of beginning teachers having a valid driver license without a conviction for a moving violation or chargeable accident on record for which a driver license is suspended or revoked for the two-year period immediately prior to employment.

A valid certification for the Driver License Division to administer knowledge and driving skills tests.

*Cooperating teachers at the school site should receive compensation for this service.
