PROCEDURE: requires summary description provided by deadline

Administrative approval:

Changes to grant application

School policy changes to be in compliance with charter and board rule

Alignment of charter with existing board rule

Change name of school

Change in curricular program if still in line with charter and state core requirements per Board rule

Non-substantive changes to grant application or charter application

Timeline for submission of applications, amendment requests, etc.

Changing governance structure to reflect best governing board practices
