

Changes to the Statewide Online Education Program (Effective May 08, 2012)

- **Course Fees** are now tiered, based on content type. Prices are for .5 Credit.
- **CCA Origination** CCA may originate with either a School Counselor or a Provider.
- Rejection of a CCA -
 - Enrollment inconsistent with SEOP.
 - Enrollment is inconsistent with an IEP.
 - Inconsistent with IB requirements.
 - Enrollment is in excess of one FTE, disregarding Release Time.
- **Fee Negotiation** A primary LEA may not reject a CCA because the LEA is negotiating or intends to negotiate an online course fee with the provider. If a primary LEA of enrollment negotiates an online course fee with a provider *before the start date of an online course*, a CCA may be amended to reflect the negotiated fee.
- Acceptance Windows -
 - Provider/ Primary LEA has 72 business hours beyond notice of a CCA to notify USOE of Acceptance or Rejection, or the CCA is considered to be accepted.
- **IEP/504** A Primary LEA of Enrollment has **72 business hours** after receiving notice of Provider acceptance of a CCA to forward an **IEP or description of 504 Accommodations** to the Provider.
- Enrollment and Enrollment Procedures -
 - Registration Timing: Enrollment should enroll during ordinary registration processes (spring or otherwise).
 - Membership/Enrollment "Cap": A Primary LEA of enrollment must include online course credit hours in calculating daily membership, and a student may not count as more than one FTE unless the student intends to complete high school graduation requirements and exit high school early, in accordance with the student's SEOP. A student enrolled in an online course may, in general, earn no more credits in a year than a student may earn in a year by taking a full course load during the regular school day in the student's primary LEA of enrollment.
 - Excess Credits: A student enrolled in an online course may, however, earn more credits in a year than a student may earn in a year by taking a full course load during the regular school day at the student's primary LEA of enrollment, under either of two conditions:
 - (a) **Funded:** the student intends to complete high school graduation requirements, and exit high school, early, in accordance with the student's SEOP); *OR*
 - (b) **Unfunded**: allowed under local school board or charter school governing board policy.
 - **Course Cap:** 2.0 Credits unless LEA or State Board of Education finds more courses to be in "best academic interest" of student.
 - **Release Time** Enrolling students may not be counted in membership for a Released-Time class, if counting the student in membership for a released-time class would result in the student being counted as more than one FTE.
- **Adding** Student may drop a traditional classroom course and add (substitute) an online course by your LEA's same established deadline for dropping and adding a traditional course.
- **Withdrawal** Students may drop an online course for 20 school calendar days after (a) semester start date; (b) enrollment if this occurs later; or (c) a second semester start date.

Beginning with the 2013-14 school year, the online course fees shall be adjusted each school year in accordance with the percentage change in the value of the weighted pupil unit from the previous school year.
