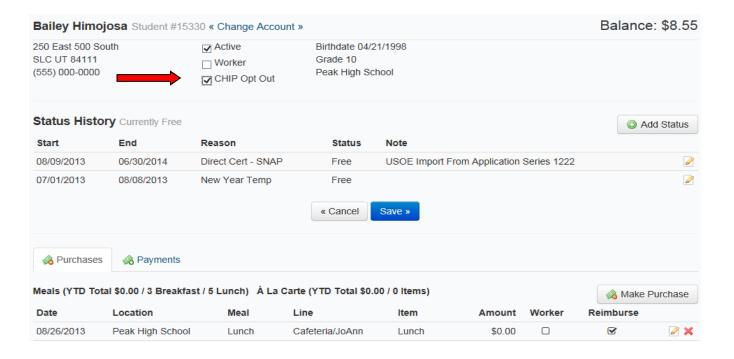


Children's Health Insurance Program



- CHIP is a Federal Health Insurance Program for 'uninsured' Utah children who qualify for Free or Reduced meals.
- For students who 'Opt Out' of participating in the CHIP program, users must select:
 CHIP 'Opt Out' option in Aspire
- Meaning "Parent does not want to be contacted regarding CHIP".

To assign CHIP to students who 'opt out' of being notified to participate in the CHIP program Go to Food Service Manage Accounts.



Select **Save**

Remember, adding **CHIP** to a student's status record is 'opting out' of being notified for Federal **H**ealth **I**nsurance **P**rogram for **uninsured** Utah children who qualify for **Free** or **Reduced** meals.

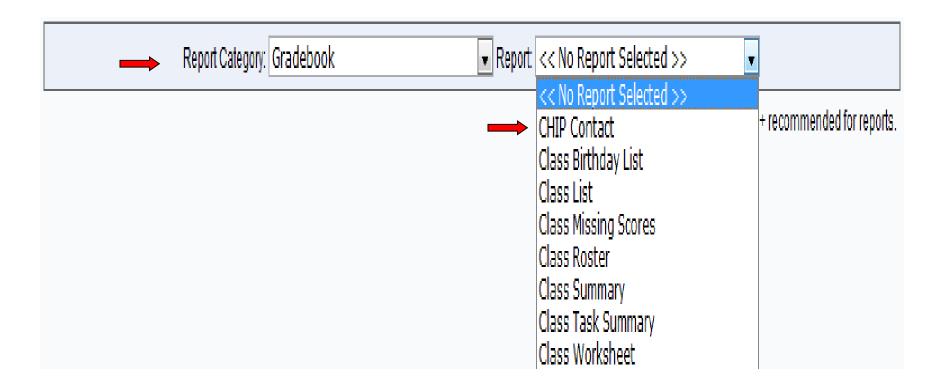
After adding students who have chosen <u>not</u> to be notified about **CHIP**,

You can go to the Aspire web site and print a report that will list all students who did <u>not</u> 'opt out' of being contacted for: Federal Health Insurance Program for <u>uninsured</u> Utah children who qualify for Free or Reduced meals. This report can be turned into the Health Department.
