SIS2000+ Web Applications



**SIS2000+ software users include: 20 school districts
and 63 charter schools.**

New Charter Schools that have joined SIS2000+ for school year 2012-2013:

Assessment Application:

State Assessment Testing Preprint data extracts have been moved to the SIS2000+ Web portal.

ACT (American College Test),
CRT (Criterion Referenced Tests),
DWA (Direct Writing Assessment),
UAA (Utah's Alternative Assessment), and
UALPA (Utah Academic Language Proficiency Assessment) testing data.

These data files are required by the state assessment department and extracted at different times during a school year. Extracting data will be easier for users via the web. After extracting the data, the files will automatically be named after the type of testing session the extract is for. Test name example: PRE_003_SPRING_LA0303_20111125_01 (1).

Assessment Application:

Reading at Grade Level and Reading Intervention data.

LEAs (schools) requested the ability for office administration to put reading at grade level and reading intervention information in for teachers, if necessary. SIS2000+ has also added the ability to export this information to an Excel spreadsheet for office administration manipulation and tracking. Also, added a report 'Reading Intervention' for assessing student needs.

Attendance Application:

A student Attendance Photo Seating Chart has been added in teacher grade book. Teachers can create a classroom seating chart in the design they want. After creating the seating chart design, teachers can add student photos to the seating chart. Teachers can take attendance in the seating chart application by selecting the students who are absent or tardy, Both elementary and secondary teachers have loved this addition to the grade book. We have found, the secondary teachers are using the photo seating chart the most.

Future Changes and Enhancements

Future Updates will include the following features:

- Moving the Attendance Module to the web. This will mean, all administrative attendance will be added via the web. Attendance secretaries will no longer use FoxPro client to add any student attendance.
- Moving the Enrollment Module to the web. This will be a large rewrite of the software.



- A special thank you to John Brandt who is retiring and will no longer work with us as our IT Director. He was a great asset to our staff.

New Attendance Reports by School and by Class:

Added a School wide Attendance Report for school administration to have the ability to see the percentage of attendance in their whole school. This report will have a break down by ethnicity and race. Reports can be run for a certain day, term, or by year.

Added a School Attendance Report by Class for school administration to be able to track attendance by the number of 'Classes Enrolled', 'Classes Attended', and 'Attendance Percentage by Class'. Reports can be run for a certain day, term, or by year. This information is very valuable for school administration to track attendance trends.

Teacher Grade Book: Added a Lunch Count by Class:

From the grade book, teachers can now submit the number of students planning to eat lunch that day. This data is submitted directly into the food service module. This assists the food service personnel in knowing how many students to prepare or order lunch for.

UTREx Clearinghouse Extract:

Derek Howard, IT Manager, created a script for the SIS2000+ users that automatically uploads the LEA (school) UTREx Clearinghouse data on a nightly basis. This UTREx Clearinghouse file is automatically placed on the UTREx Clearinghouse Data Collector server. Users are relieved of the task of uploading this file themselves. Since this file is automatically placed on the Data Collector Server, users can login directly to the Data Collector Server and simply process the file.

UTREx Clearinghouse SIF Agent:

We have the programming completed that is necessary to work with the UTREx Clearinghouse SIF process. We are waiting on the UTREx contractor to finish the SIF agent.

Report Servers:

We have implemented new report servers to increase the speed of the reporting services for our users.

You will see less and less information about the SIS2000+ Client side of the software because a lot of the changes and improvements will move directly to the web. Eventually we will have all software applications moved to the web.

Food Service Module:

Added 'online payment' information fields to student and faculty accounts.

More and more schools are allowing parents (contacts) and faculty to pay for their school meals via a web service using a credit card. Users will still need to manually add the online payment amount information into SIS2000+ faculty and student Food Service Payment accounts. We added the online payment fields on the Monthly Payment Summary Reports for account balancing and tracking.
