

# **Magic Stack-n-Whack Quilt** **(Kaleidoscope Pinwheel Design)**

## **Fabric and Supply List:**

### **Fabric:**

Main Print-3 yards-(estimate-see below)  
Coordinating fabric for pinwheels-1 yard

**Hint:** Choose fabric with a medium to large print and very little background. The design in the fabric needs to repeat no less than every 12". If it repeats after more than 12", it will work. You need 8 design repeats to make this quilt. It is important that you count the repeats before cutting off your yardage. 3 yards of main print is generally a close estimate of what you will need. This quilt finishes at approximately 50" X 50" with 16 blocks.

### **Border Fabric:**

There is some of the main print fabric left over for one of the borders. It also looks good to use the pinwheel fabric in a border of which you would need to purchase more if desired. I am not including yardage measurements for the borders because it depends on what you like. I will show you some ideas at the class.

### **Supplies:**

Fabric  
Rotary cutter with a NEW blade  
Ruler  
Flathead Flower pins- (important for the cutting process)  
Thread  
Sewing kit
