



- A. Get a virtual locker.**
 - a. Don't forget your number or your password.**
 - b. If you want each class separate, you need to have different accounts.**
 - c. Create your account!**
 - B. Four categories: Images, Learning Segments, Testing, and Media Shows.**
 - a. Tutorials**
 - C. Saving others work to your own locker.**
 - a. You have to be logged on.**
 - b. Click on the folder that you would like to save.**
 - c. The copy folder icon shows up.**
 - d. Clicking this icon will save the complete folder to your folder and you can edit it there.**
 - e. Find a someone's work you are interested in and save it to your locker.**
 - D. Creating your own work.**
 - a. Make sure you save, it does not prompt you to do so.**
 - b. Private and Community Buttons**
 - c. Test, Quiz, Exam, Trivia Game**
 - d. Open book icon the kids get to choose a second time if they missed it, but it lowers their score. Closed book icon they only get one shot at it.**
