



Novell and the Utah State Office of Education are pleased to present the annual Young Network Professionals (YNP) Scholarship Awards. This award honors high school seniors who have demonstrated high-tech experience and leadership abilities in their schools and communities.

One grand-prize winner will receive a \$3,000 scholarship, while additional winners will receive scholarships up to \$2,000. Winners are selected by the YNP Scholarship Committee, which consists of representatives from the Utah State Office of Education (USOE) and Novell.

All applicants must be high school seniors who have taken, or are currently taking, the Novell CNA or SUSE LINUX Fundamentals course and who have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0. To apply, students are required to submit the following:

- YNP cover letter with student photo
- 2 teacher recommendations
- A student resume
- An academic transcript
- An essay of 1,000 words or less on the topic, "How a Novell certification will help me achieve my future goals"
- A copy of their Novell CNA, Novell Linux Certification, or CompTIA Linux+ certification or score report if completed (CNA, Novell Linux Certification, or Linux+ certification is not required to apply for this scholarship, but proof of certification must be submitted to USOE prior to receiving any scholarship monies if the applicant is selected).
- Signed Media Release Form

Applications must be postmarked by Friday, February 3, 2012.
