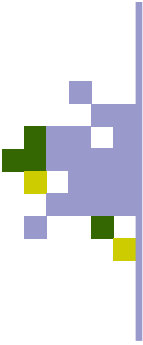




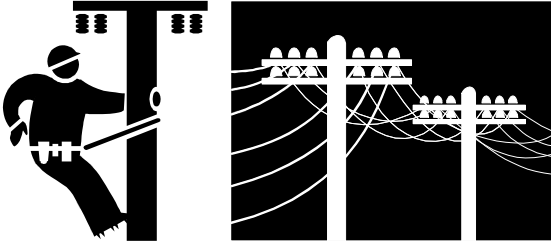
Kids Marketplace

Kids Marketplace is an interactive money management program that was developed in Virginia and is now being used here in Utah. This is a simulation of the "real world". All students are randomly assigned a job and given play money as their monthly income. They are given time to visit each of 8 -10 stations, which represent spending categories (housing, transportation, fun, etc.), with the goal to visit all the stations and either break even or have money left over at the "end of the month".
