COURSE PREFACE

Description

Related Work-Based Learning provides on the job training opportunities that are directly related to a career goal and course of study identified through the SEOP. This Work-Based Learning experience is designed to bridge the gap between school and work. Appropriate supervision by a school/district coordinator must be maintained. Examples of Related Work-Based Learning include student internship, cooperative work experience and school-based enterprise.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

- **Supervision by School Staff**
Maintain appropriate teacher to student ratios for teaching load
- **Employer Coordination Visits**
School staff conducts onsite safety visit prior to placement and monthly follow-up visits
- **SEOP Alignment**
Student placement tied to a career goal driven by the SEOP process
- **Related CTE Class to Work-Based Learning Placement**
Student enrolled in related CTE class
- **Skills/Learning Grids**
Develop placement specific grid for WBL placement
- **Accountability Pieces**
Use journal, time cards, etc.
