Become an expert at . . .

- Developing in students a love for Art, Dance, Drama, and/or Music
- Mastering the Core skills and understanding required of K-6 students in a given art form
- Using student-friendly, positive teaching/learning methods that nurture the development of the Whole Child
- Consistently weaving perceiving and reflecting moments into teaching/learning experiences
- Competently producing a classroom arts demonstration and/or informance
- Showing insight in helping students use their core knowledge and skills in an art form to learn and/or demonstrate learning in other subjects, and the reverse
- Gathering, organizing and using quality, essential teaching/learning resources in the art form

Be a Leader

- Attend and participate in as many visual and performing arts events, concerts, exhibitions and festivals as you can. For opportunities visit www.nowplayingutah.org. Many organizations will provide free or discounted tickets to educators.
- Be the school curriculum leader for elementary art, dance, music, and/or theatre events, festivals.
- Be the School Arts Committee Chair ...could also serve as the contact person for POPS visits, the rep to district arts committee meetings, or the arts rep on the school community council.
- Be the school arts professional learning community organizer.
- Be an assistant to the District Arts Coordinator for district-wide festivals or Arts Professional Development events.
- Attend conferences on the arts and bring the information back to the other teachers at your school.

Be an Arts Instructor/Sponsor/Presenter

- Be responsible to teach art, dance, music, or theatre for your grade-level team.
- Be an arts coach to another teacher wanting to learn how to teach an art form.
- Organize and manage the Arts materials for teacher checkout.
- Collaborate in creating arts-integrated units for your grade-level team.
- Do an extra-curricular school arts club or program for your students.
