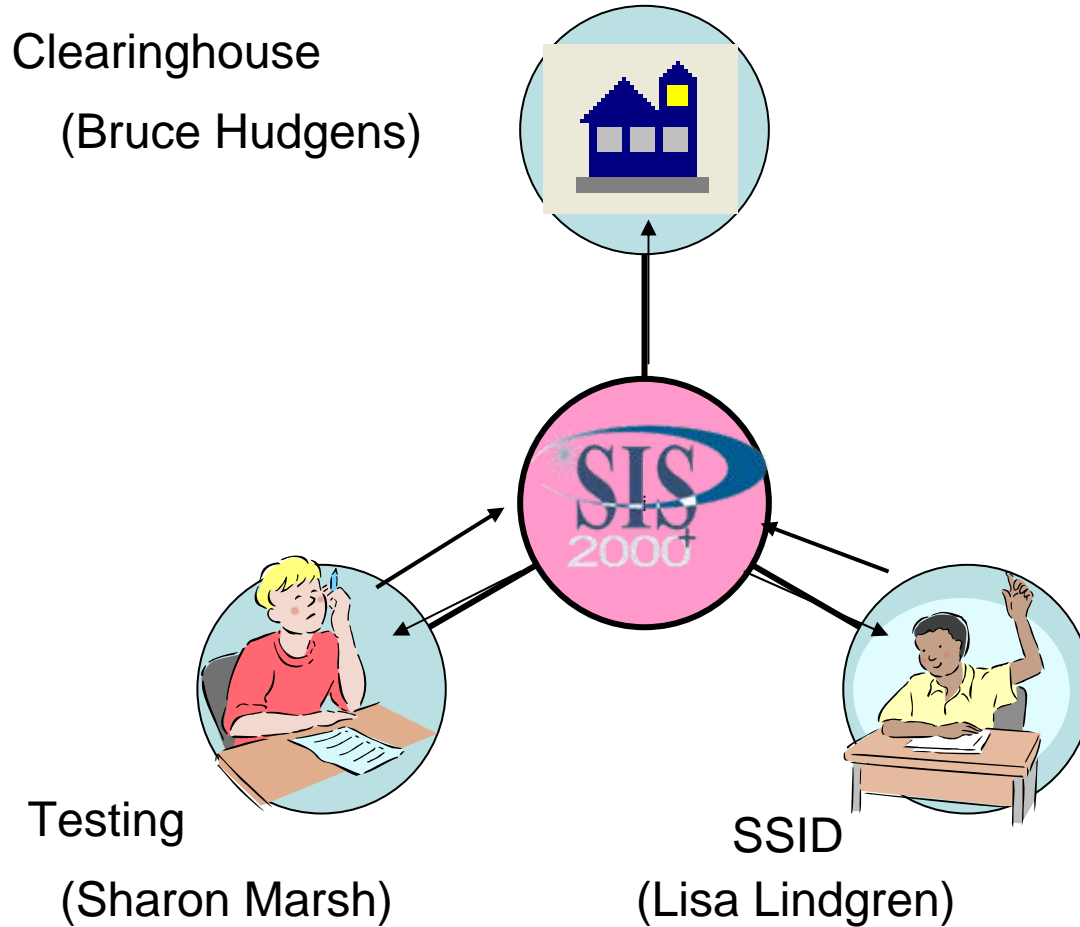

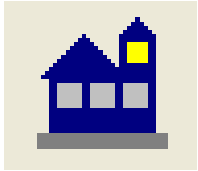


System Updates

 - Remote Desktop (terminal server)



- **One unique logon id for each person**
 - Use for both FoxPro and Web Portal



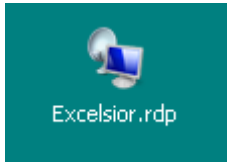
- **'sa' logon id = FoxPro System Administrator**




- **'cmadmin' logon id = Web Control Master**
