Utah Schools for the Deaf and the Blind

FY22 Enrichment Funds increase for USD and USB

Susan Patten, Associate Superintendent of the Blind, and Michelle Tanner, Associate Superintendent of the Deaf, discussed the Advisory Council recommendation to increase the Utah School of the Deaf (USD) Enrichment Fund travel from \$15,000 to \$50,000 (an increase of \$35,000) due to COVID-19 restrictions. In addition, Ms. Patten will discuss the Advisory Council recommendation to add \$45,000 to the Utah School of the Blind (USB) trip for the Seventy-48 boat race.

Board approves the Advisory Council recommended changes to the USD and USB Enrichment funds.

Study Session

<u>Bullying Prevention, including an Overview and Training of R277-613, Local Education Agency</u>
(LEA) Policies

The Utah State Board of Education staff Angie Stallings, Deputy Superintendent of Policy, Tanya Albornoz, Prevention Specialist, and Amy Steele-Smith, Prevention Specialist presented an update on the reporting processes and the purposes of Board rule R277-613: Local Education Agency (LEA) Policies and Training Regarding Bullying, Cyber-bullying, Hazing, Retaliation, and Abusive Conduct.

The purpose of the rule is to:

- (a) require LEAs to develop, update, and implement bullying, cyber-bullying, hazing, retaliation, and abusive conduct policies at the school district and school level;
 - (b) provide for regular and meaningful training of school employees and students;
- (c) provide for enforcement of the policies in schools, at the state level and in public school athletic programs; and
- (d) require an LEA to review allegations of bullying, cyber-bullying, hazing, retaliation, and abusive conduct.
