During February, how will you celebrate CTE Month® in your SCHOOL?

As part of your staff and student recognition program, this event can add spirit to your school and will strengthen morale.

Goals of CTE Month:

- Inform students about the importance of choosing a <u>CTE Career Pathway</u>.
- Increase student awareness of careers, education, and training.
- Strengthen student engagement through the <u>Plan for College and Career Readiness</u>.
- Increase parent/guardian involvement and awareness of CTE programs.
- Promote discussion of postsecondary options—training, certificates, and degrees.

What Can You Do to Promote CTE Month® in Your SCHOOL?

Consider doing the following activities part of your celebration:

- Advocate for CTE, and your program, by sharing success stories of <u>CTE teachers</u> and <u>students</u> with <u>Utah CTE</u>, your principal, school board, local community, and legislative representatives.
 - Arrange to make presentations (in-person or virtual) to school and student organizations on the value of partnerships with CTE.
 - o Contact the media about the highlighting the events taking place in your school.
 - o Share the CTE Month announcement flyer with school and student organizations.
 - Host an open house at your school highlighting the importance of CTE.
- Distribute copies of public relations materials to your teachers.
- Decorate your school with banners and posters.
- Display an exhibit in your school featuring CTE Month activities.
 - Plan an in-person or virtual event to answer questions about Career and Technical Education.
- Post announcements to your school website, marquee, and bulletin boards.
- Use a special greeting promoting CTE Month in the morning school announcements and when answering telephones.
- Recognize CTE teachers and students.
- Social Media:
 - Post highlights of the CTE Month events in your school on social media.
 - Write a blog highlighting the CTE programs available in your school. Post the blog on your school website.
