Can a student defer the scholarship?

The student must be meeting satisfactory academic progress (SAP) at SLCC to be eligible for this award.

If students are awarded a scholarship, when will those funds be available to them?

Funds may disburse 1 week prior to the beginning of the semester as long as the student is enrolled in the minimum

number of required credits and/or has no holds.
