Can a student defer the scholarship?

No. Due to the funding for this scholarship varies, it is not deferrable, but student may apply for it annually.

Who can apply for the CTE Scholarship and Tuition Award?

U.S. Citizen/Permanent Resident
H-1B Visa (e.g., DACA)

Are the scholarships full-tuition?

Yes.

A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the Fall and end in the Spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?
