Yes. The scholarship cannot pass the maximum allowable limit. They must be fully admitted to Snow College by March 1, 2025. Private scholarship money needs to be applied for from November 1 - March 1.

What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?

Snow College-Richfield is an open enrollment institution.

If students are awarded a scholarship, when will those funds be available to them?

Usually about 1 week before the semester begins.
