Can a student defer the scholarship?

Yes.

What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship? A student must request a deferral in writing and be approved by the Financial Aid Coordinator at the institution.

Who can apply for the CTE Scholarship and Tuition Award:

U.S. Citizen/Permanent Resident

Are the scholarships full-tuition?

If the scholarship is not full-tuition, what is the dollar amount?

Three courses, available for renewal (based upon program).

A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the Fall and end in the Spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?

Yes.
