U.S. Citizen/Permanent Resident Legal and Current Visa Status (e.g. F1 Academic Visa) H-1B Visa (e.g. DACA), Graduate of Utah High School

Are the scholarships full-tuition?

If the scholarship is not full-tuition, what is the dollar amount?

\$2000 for the year (\$1000 for Fall and \$1000 for Spring)
