Developing (70-79pts) Covers most requirements and approaching industry standards. Student was somewhat prepared and provided at least 75% of the completed oral and written project.

Novice (0-69pts) Requirements not met or seldom met. Student was unprepared and provided less than 75% of the completed oral and written project.
