State Superintendent's Statement on the Appointment of Brittney Cummins as Senior Advisor for Education for Governor-elect Cox

SALT LAKE CITY – Utah State Superintendent of Public Instruction Sydnee Dickson issued the following statement on Governor-elect Spencer Cox's appointment of Utah State Board of Education Vice Chair Brittney Cummins as his Senior Advisor for Education.

"We are very sorry to be losing Brittney Cummins's valuable experience, thoughtfulness, and steady hand at the Utah State Board of Education. But we are equally delighted that she will continue to work improving conditions of equity and student outcomes in her position in the new administration. Brittney's six years of service, most recently as Chair of the Audit Committee and Vice Chair of the Board, are marked by increased financial accountability, a better educator licensing system, new strategic direction for the Board, and improved relationships with the Legislature and with districts and charter schools. Governor-elect Cox has made an excellent choice."
