



2013 Cohort Graduation and Dropout Rate Report

State Cohort Graduation Rate Highlights

- 81% is the statewide graduation rate for 2013.
- Graduation rates have increased by 3% from 2012 to 2013.
- Since 2008 the graduation rate has increased by 12% and dropout rates have decreased by 16%.
- The graduation rate for Hispanic students has increased by 6% from 2012 to 2013.
- The graduation rate for students with disabilities has increased by 4%.
- There were 42,688 students graduated in 2013.

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Background

To align with federal NCLB regulations for graduation rate calculations, the four-year cohort rate (for 2013 includes all students who started 9th grade in 2009-10 plus transfers). By aligning with federal regulations Utah is able to compare their graduation rate to rates in other states. This rate is used for all UCAS and Grading Schools calculations. Utah also still maintains a three-year cohort rate for comparison among all Utah Local Education Agencies (LEAs), since Utah has many 10-12th grade high schools.

For both the four-year and three-year rates, there are four categories of calculation: Graduates, Dropouts, Continuing Students, and Other Completers. The “graduate” category only includes students who have earned a basic high school diploma or an adult education secondary diploma (Carnegie Units) achieved by September 30, 2013. Students considered “other completers” include those students who participate in the General Education Development test (GED) or a Certificate of Completion, and students with disabilities who participated in the Utah Alternate Assessment (UAA). Students considered to be “continuing students” are students with disabilities (continued enrollment allowed until age 22), or those who transfer to higher education or the Utah College of Applied Technology (UCAT) without receiving a high school diploma. The “dropout” category includes students such as those who have withdrawn, dropped out, or been expelled. Under the federal requirements, students who take longer than four years after entering 9th grade to receive their regular high school diploma are also considered a dropout.

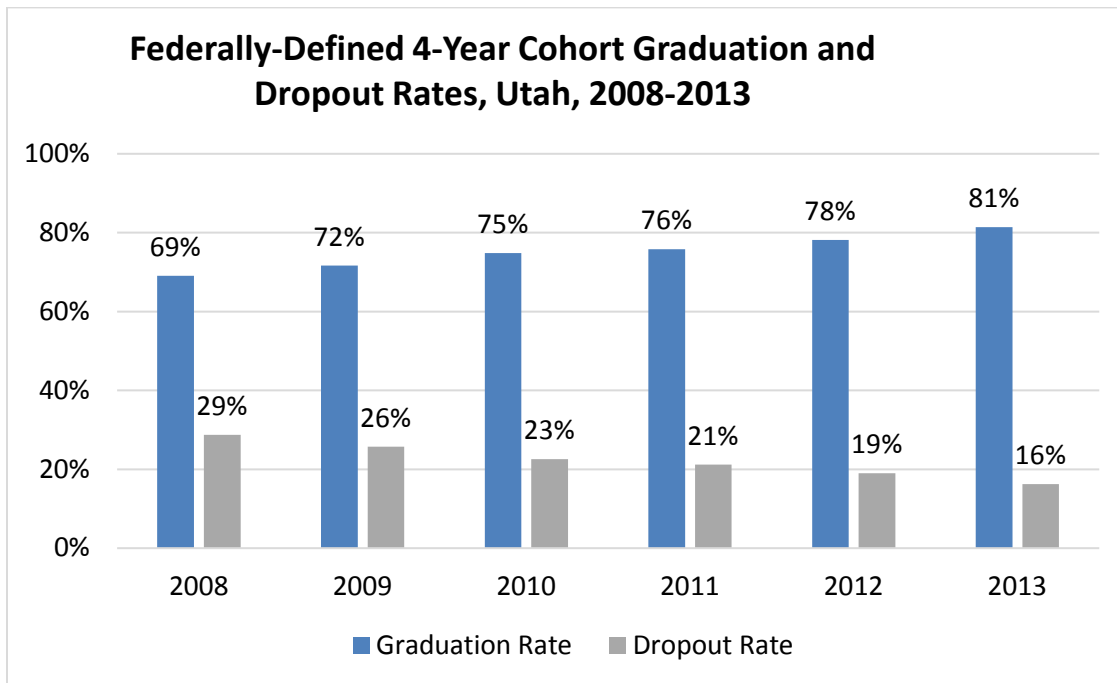

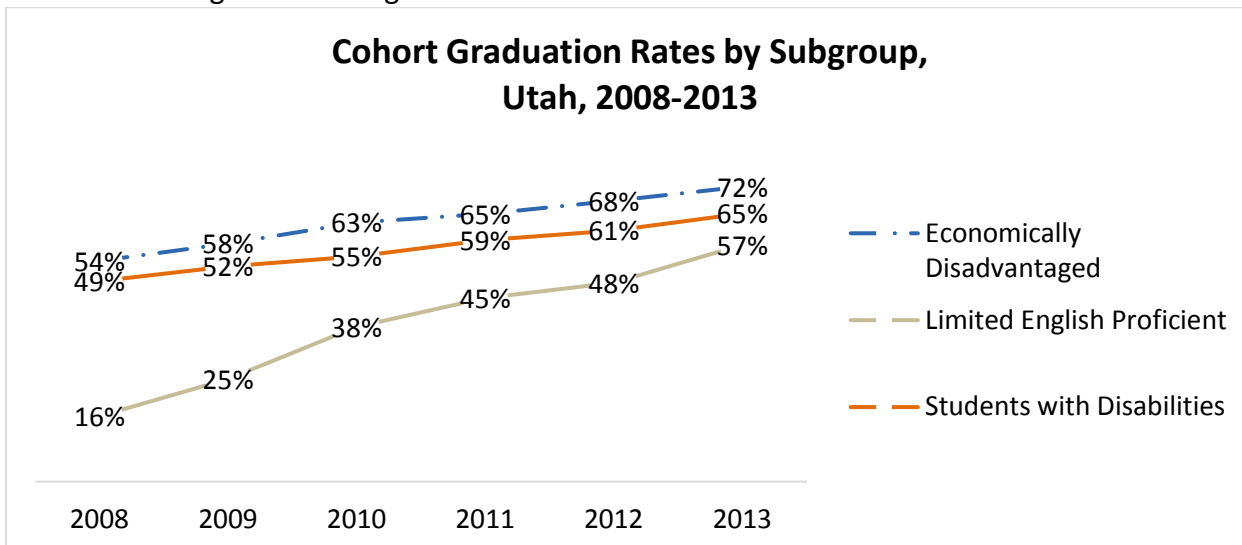
Federal Four Year Graduate Rate

Longitudinal Comparisons

Utah's graduation rate has increased by 12 percentage points over the last five years. In the same period, the dropout rate has declined by 13 percentage points since. Continuing students and other completers have remained fairly constant and constitute about 2-3% of the cohort.



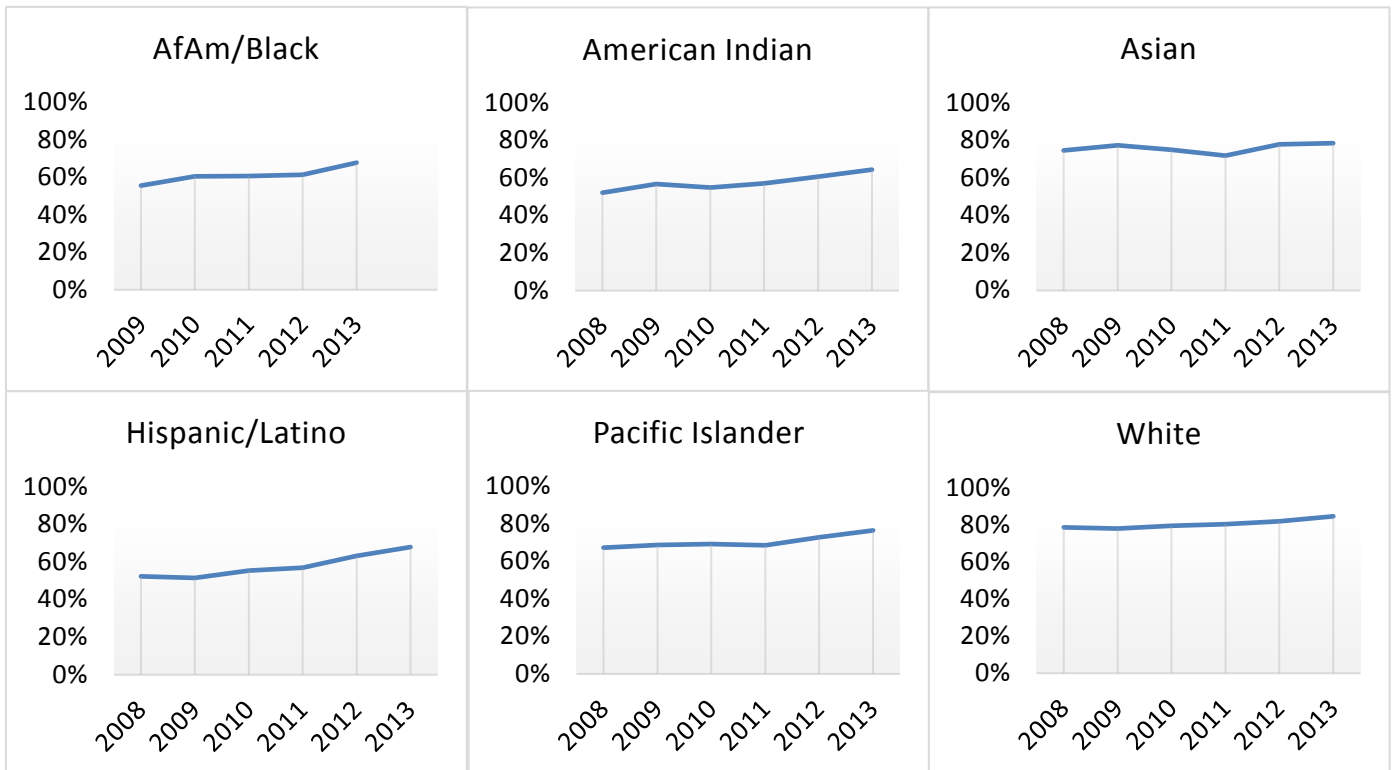
Economically disadvantaged, English language learners, and students with disabilities have all made gains in their graduation rates.
