Nationally SkillsUSA = 421,139 members in 2,164 chapters in all 50 states, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.

SkillsUSA Utah = 2,053 members in 104 chapters

Since its founding in 1965, SkillsUSA has served 13 million total annual members.

In 2018, at the SkillsUSA National Leadership and Skills Conference (NLSC), Utah ranked eighth in medals received.

More than 20,000 teachers and school administrators serve as professional SkillsUSA members and advisors.

At the 2018 SkillsUSA National Leadership and Skills Conference, 6,273 state champions competed in 100 hands-on occupational and leadership skill areas.

TEACHING

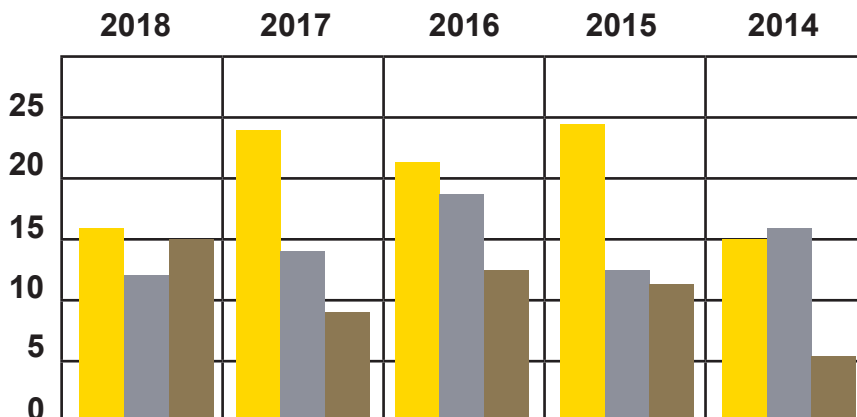
