Nationally FBLA = 196,964 members in 5,232 chapters in 47 states.

FBLA has members in Brazil, the Cayman Islands, China, Europe, Haiti, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

The FBLA concept was developed in 1937 by Dr. Hamden L. Forkner of Columbia University.

Utah FBLA has seven state officers serving their members throughout the year. These officers are responsible for the state's program of work and working with local chapters to achieve success.

FBLA has a middle school division for students in grades 5-9.

FBLA has a college division, Phi Beta Lambda, for students in postsecondary education.

Utah FBLA awards \$1,500 in scholarships and over \$5,000 in cash awards each year.

TEACHING

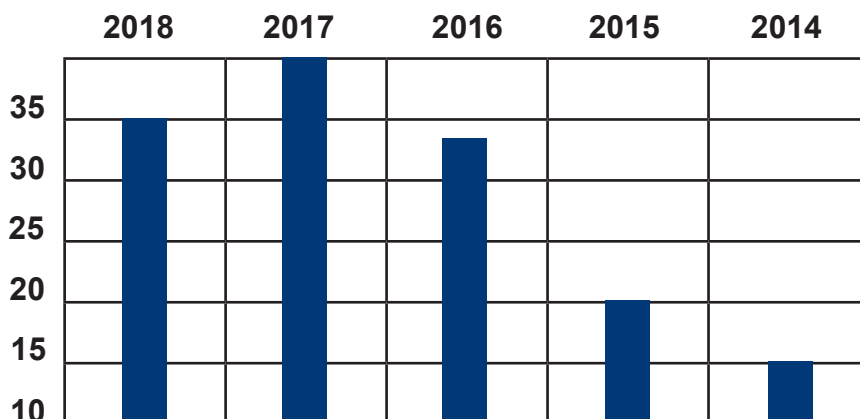
