CREDIT OPTIONS

Two forms of credit will be offered: 1.0 USBE credit **or** up to 16 relicensure points (1 point per hour). The only option for those who attend less than two full days will be relicensure points. Per USBE Rule (R277-519-4-1b), those seeking USBE credit must “complete a 4-hour assigned learning task or reflection.” USBE credit will not be awarded until the assigned work is received. We will also have an option for USU–1.8 CEU credits for \$54. Please check with your district to determine if they accept CEU credit for lane change.
