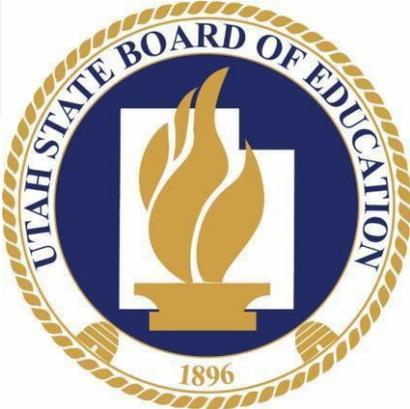
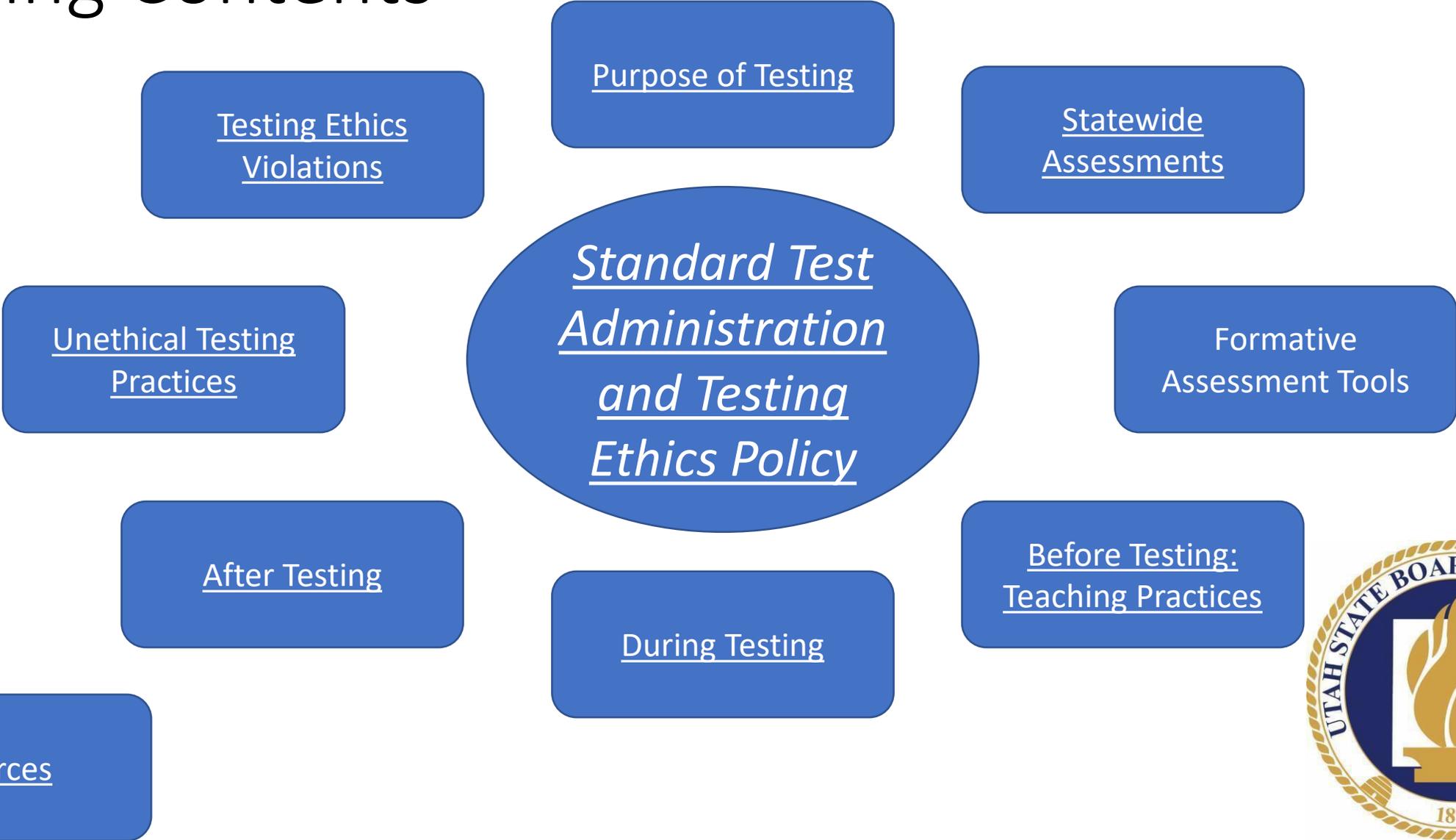

Purpose of Testing

“When **administered properly**, statewide assessments allow students to demonstrate what they know and can do.”

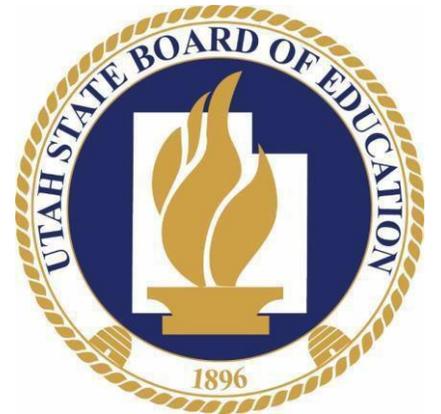

If your actions will cause student to NOT receive a valid and reliable score, that accurately reflects what they know and can do, don't do it!

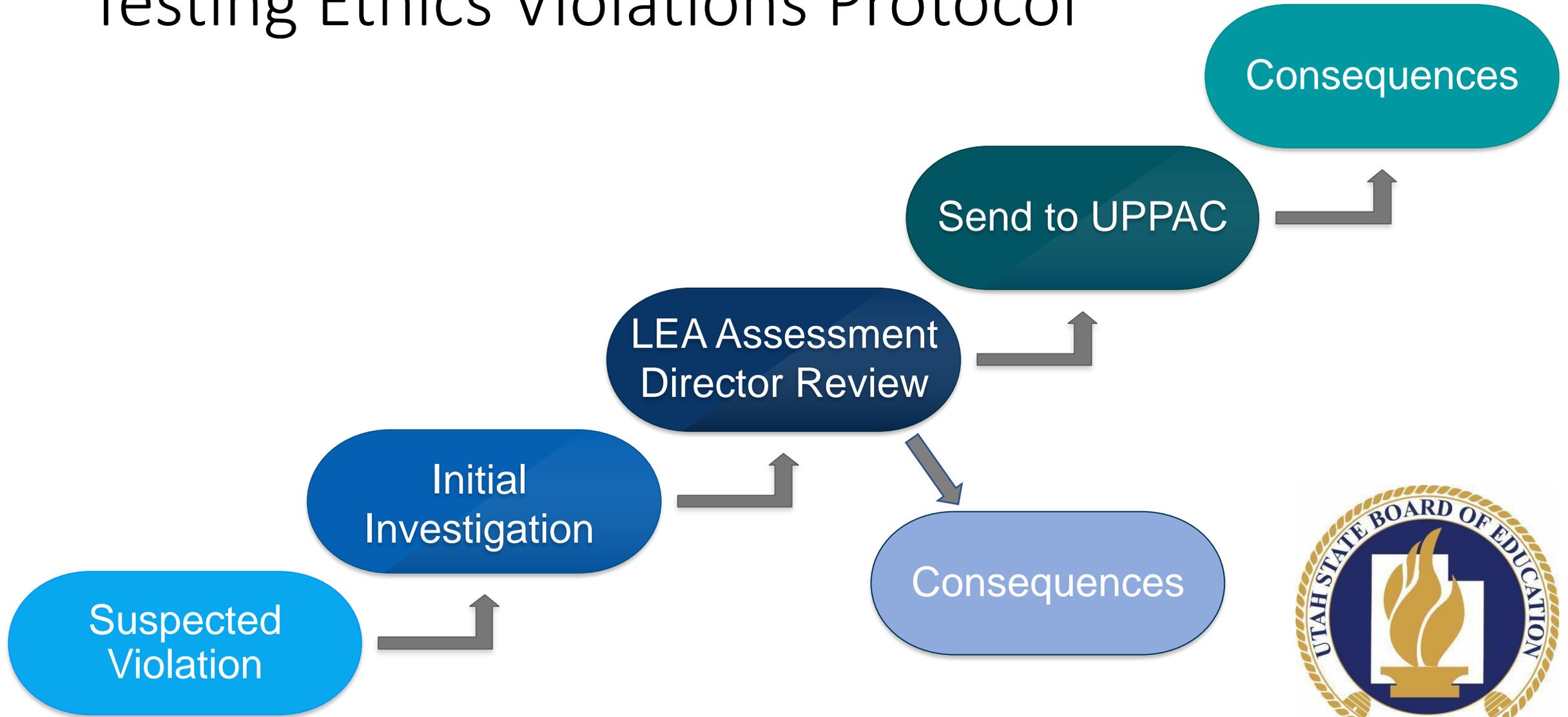
