**Can a student defer the scholarship?**

Yes.

**What criteria does your institution have regarding students who want to defer the scholarship?**

**Are the scholarships full-tuition?**

**If the scholarship is not full-tuition, what is the dollar amount?**

The scholarships are a one-time annual award of \$2000 (\$1000 for Fall and \$1000 for Spring).

**A one-year scholarship or tuition award generally implies that students start in the Fall and end in the Spring. Can students access this scholarship in the summer?**

**Can a student accept this scholarship and another scholarship from your institution? If yes, what is the criteria?**

Yes. Academic scholarships may be combined up to the cost of resident tuition only.

**What admission criteria/GPA standards are in place for entering freshman at your institution, if any?**

As an open-enrollment institution, students need a high school diploma or equivalent to be admitted to WSU.

**If students are awarded a scholarship, when will those funds be available to them?**

Scholarships will be awarded to incoming freshman by July 1. Scholarships will be applied to a student's account and officially pay out the week before the semester begins.
