

Credit Recovery & Remediation

Informational Paper on School Fees



LEAs are required to provide remediation courses to secondary students who do not meet competency levels in English, Mathematics, Science, or Social Studies. LEAs are also permitted to charge a fee for participation in these courses as provided in 53G-9-803.

LEAs may also make credit recovery courses available to secondary students who need to repeat or retake a course in order to graduate.

As participation in these classes increases a student's competency levels and helps them to meet graduation requirements, any charge associated with these courses is considered a fee. These fees shall be listed on the LEAs fee schedule and are subject to fee waivers.

Additionally, beginning with the 2022-23 school year, any instructional material provided for a student to complete a remediation or credit recovery course, is considered a textbook and shall be provided free of charge.
