All Professional License renewals require **prior review and approval of 100 hours (minimum) completed** within the last five (5) years prior to date of license expiration. *Professional License renewals are subject to audit by the Utah State Board of Education.* As such, you are required to keep this original signed renewal worksheet and supporting documentation for 24 months *as evidence to support your online renewal transaction.* The rules and steps for Utah Educator License Renewal can be found at [Renew/Upgrade a Utah Educator License](#).
