# Definitions:



- ***Primary LEA of enrollment:*** the school district or charter school enrolling a student for purposes other than SOEP courses.
- ***Primary school of enrollment:*** a student's *school of record* that maintains the student's cumulative file, enrollment information and transcript.
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- ***Online course provider:*** a charter school or district school created exclusively for the purpose of serving students online, or an LEA program created exclusively for the purpose of serving students online.

## Membership R277-419

A student remains in regular and special education membership at the Primary School of Enrollment for the sum of all credit hours completed or undertaken at both:

1. The primary school of enrollment, and
2. The online provider.

# The Primary LEA of Enrollment

Utilizing SOEP, a student remains regularly enrolled in a single LEA – the Primary LEA - which facilitates access to online courses supplied by a companion LEA.

The Primary LEA directs the student's education.



Enroll through the Utah State Board of Education's (USBE) web-application, "Student Enrollment and Tracking System" (SEATS).



SEATS establishes a contractual agreement between the student's primary LEA of enrollment and a provider.



SEATS notifies a counselor and other staff to adjust membership to account for additional coursework.

**To enroll in an online course, students must enroll using SEATS.**

# A student is limited to full-time enrollment – unless they plan to graduate early

## Full-time enrollment:

The number of credits a student may earn in a year by taking a full course load (1.0 FTE) during the regular school day in the student's primary LEA of enrollment.

**Summer courses** are tabulated with courses taken across the next regular academic year.



# Balancing a Student's Course Load

Unless a student's early graduation plan allows the student to exceed full-time enrollment, SOEP courses **replace** courses taught at a primary school of enrollment, credit per credit.



# Increased Course Load?


Extra funding is obtained by:

- 1. Putting Early Graduation Plan in place.
- 2. Recording Course in student's Schedule
- 3. Marking the student as an Early Grad
- 4. Increasing Membership

# 6-8<sup>th</sup> graders

Under an [approved plan for early graduation](#) 6-8<sup>th</sup> graders enrolled in a secondary environment may also earn [credit toward high school graduation](#) utilizing this program.

# Statutory Approval – the BA’s role



For the primary LEA of enrollment, if a **primary approver** does not respond to a request in 72 business hours following its filing in SEATS, the request is [statutorily approved](#).

# The Counselor's Role

A Counselor ensures credit does not exceed the school's definition of full-time enrollment unless a student has a plan for Early Graduation Plan, and [membership is increased commensurately](#).

A Counselor works with a Registrar to record SOEP in a student's schedule in a local Student Information System (SIS).

# UTREx Course Entry

If courses are not entered into a local SIS, the LEA is not funded for the courses – but it does receive a **bill**.


