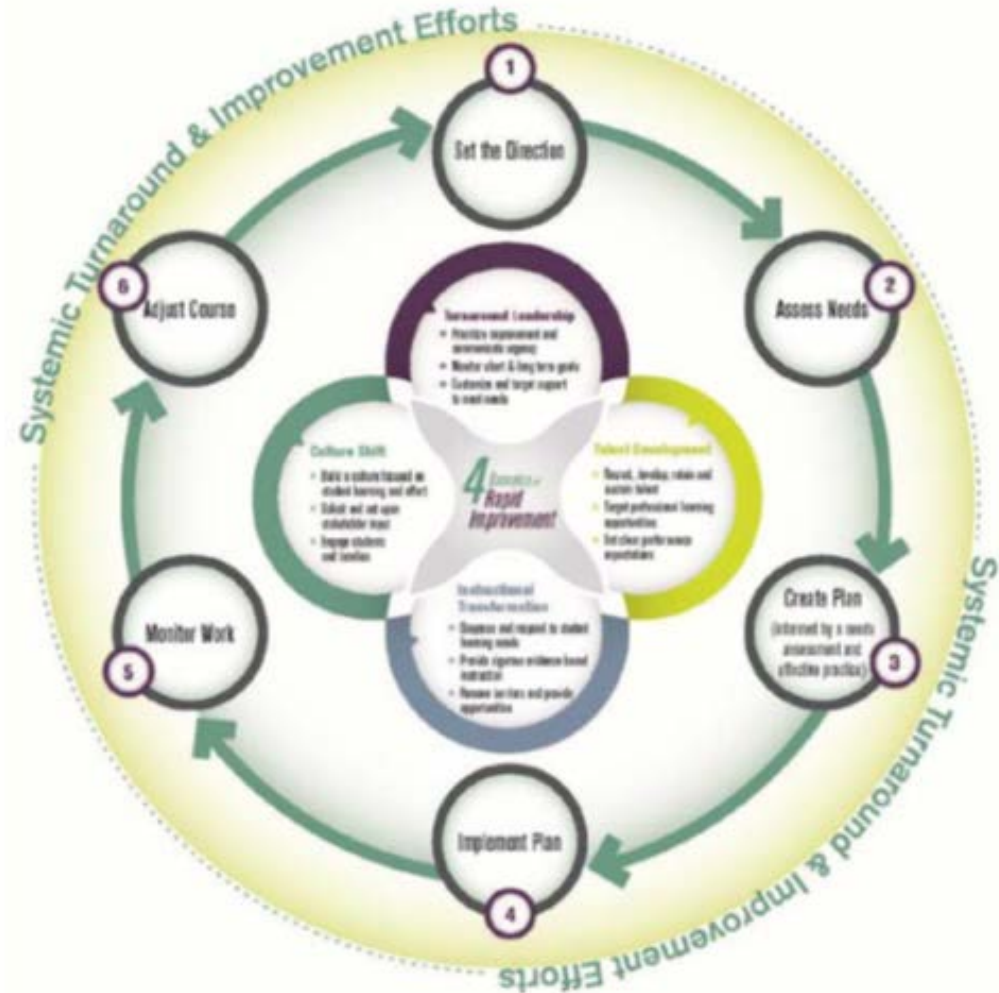

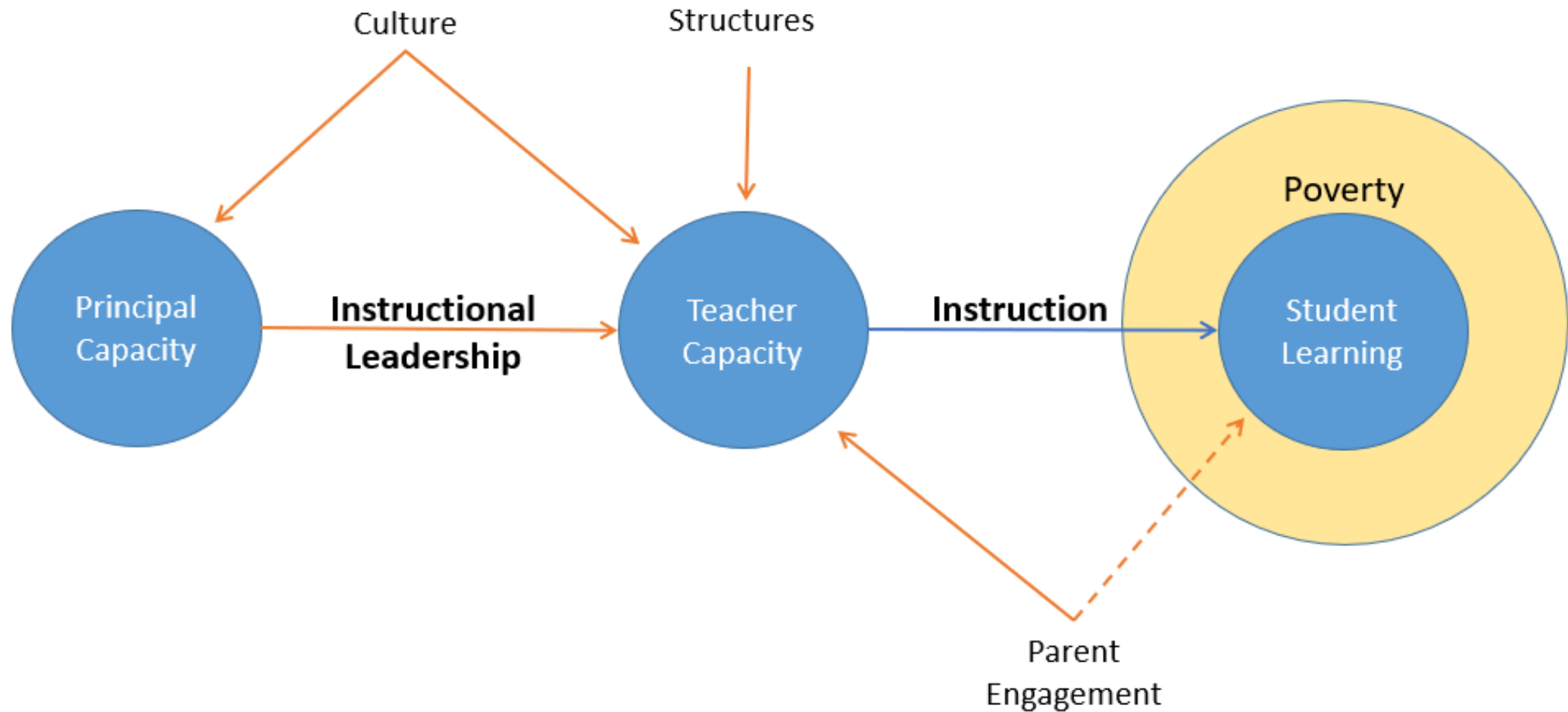

Good – Better – Best

Involvement	Engagement	Empowerment
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Usually a one way interaction• The family member attends an event and gains information about the school, the student or the classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Builds the capacity of the family member to support learning.• Builds a relationship of trust• Links the interaction directly to improving learning.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Reciprocal interaction• Family and staff learn• Family uses new skills to advocate for student learning
