



Educator Quality and Licensing

Requirements to teach *Athletic Skills Development*

High School Principal:

In 2007, *Athletic Skills Development* was created to allow athletic skills courses to be conducted for “elective only” credit. It requires that an instructor have a current teaching license, and that if the license is in any other area than physical education, the instructor must be certified to coach through a coaching education program authorized by the Utah High School Activities Association.

The Utah State Board of Education will evaluate all listed personnel and make recommendations for the endorsement to teach *Athletic Skills Development*.

If a cheerleader advisor is conducting the skill development course, documentation of the most recent cheerleader advisor training must be attached with a copy of a card showing certification in First Aid/CPR.
