

Requirements for Driver Education Endorsement

Endorsement requires completion of all **SIX** steps and consists of 16 semester hours

1. **A) Health Education 3500** – University of Utah credit (2 semester hours).
- OR -
B) Health Education 350 – Non-matriculated student (2 USBE credits). Same class as Health Education 3500. All participants must register through the University of Utah continuing education and elect non-matriculated student
2. **A) Health Education 3510** - University of Utah credit (2 semester hours).
- OR -
B) Health Education 351 – Non-matriculated student (2 USBE credits). Same class as Health Education 3510. All participants must register through the University of Utah continuing education and elect non-matriculated student.
3. **A) Health Education 3910** – Practicum Hours. University of Utah credit (8 semester hours).
- OR –
B) Practicum 391 – You do not need to register for this course if you elect USBE credit (8 USBE credits). The course logs 120 hours of driver education teaching and observation time. This is student teaching for driver education. Participants must log hours observed. Participants may not drive or teach without direct supervision of a certified mentor. The mentor must be a certified driver education instructor, currently teaching driver education.

4. **Driver Education State Law and Policy** – Utah Education Network (2 USBE credits or 2 SUU semester hours). Participants elect credit option when registering for class.
5. **Examiners Training** – Online examiner training: <http://elearning.post.utah.gov/st1/>. This training can be completed at any time. Participants are required to print completion certificate and submit with endorsement application.
6. **Current CPR/First Aid card** – A copy of both front and back of their certification card must be submitted with endorsement application.

State Approved Endorsement Plan

SAEP allows the instructor to teach the classroom and BTW portions of driver education, until your endorsement is complete. ***You are not allowed to test students under an SAEP***

Requirements:

1. Completion of two of the following three: Health Education 350, 351 or Law and Policy, **and**
2. Sixty Practicum hours (4 hours), **and**
3. Current CPR/First Aid card, **and**
4. An official letter, on school letterhead, from an administrator requesting the need for a driver education instructor.
