3	R277-623-1. Authority and Purpose.
4	(1) This rule is authorized by:
5	(a) Utah Constitution Article X, Section 3, which vests general control and
6	supervision over public education in the Board;
7	(b) Section 53E-3-401(4), which allows the Board to make rules to execute the
8	Board's duties and responsibilities under the Utah Constitution and state law; and
9	(c) Section 53G-8-802(2)(i), which requires the Board to make rules requiring an
10	LEA to:
11	(i) create or adopt and disseminate a school climate survey; and
12	(ii) disseminate the school climate survey.
13	(2) The purpose of this rule is to provide an LEA with:
14	(a) the recommended distribution method;
15	(b) climate survey frequency; and
16	(c) minimum sample size required to conduct a climate survey.
17	
18	R277-623-2. Definitions.
19	(1) "School Climate Survey" or "climate survey" means a survey that evaluates a
20	range of aspects of the educational environment to assess perceptions and identify
21	specific strengths and weaknesses within a school.
22	(2) "School Community" means [all] relevant stakeholders including:
23	(a) parents;
24	(b) students;
25	(c) administration;
26	(d) school building staff including teachers; and
27	(e) school resource officers as defined in Subsection 53G-8-701(2).

29	R277-623-3. Incorporation of [Model]Required School Climate Survey Questions

30	by Reference.
31	(1) This rule incorporates by reference the Model School Climate Survey.
32	(2) A copy of the model survey is located at:
33	(a) https://www.schools.utah.gov/ ; and
34	(b) the Utah State Board of Education.
35	
36	R277-623-4. Climate Survey Administration.
37	(1) An LEA shall administer a school climate survey containing the questions
38	identified in the Model School Climate Survey described in Section R277-623-3.
39	(2) An LEA may include additional questions in the LEA's climate survey
40	consistent with student data privacy requirements as described in Section 53E-9-203.
41	(3) An LEA shall administer the climate survey:
42	(a) at least once every other year and in the opposite year from administration of
43	the public education exit and engagement survey described in R277-325;
44	(b) in an anonymous and randomized way;
45	(c) to the LEA's school community;
46	(d) in other languages relevant to the school community where possible;
47	(e) to students across all academic achievement levels; and
48	(f) in a form compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
49	(4) An LEA may administer the survey orally to a student if:
50	(a) the LEA provides methods to protect the confidentiality of the student's
51	responses;
52	(b) the student can request for a different survey administrator; and
53	(c) the LEA provides methods to protect the confidentiality and identity of the
54	survey administrator from the general public.
55	(5) An LEA shall administer the climate survey through a Board approved online
56	provider.
57	(6) An LEA shall provide the survey to:
58	(a) the lesser of 35% of the student population or 400 students;

59	(b) each school in the LEA; and
60	(c) [all] staff at a school level.
61	[(6) If an LEA fails to administer the survey, the Superintendent may pursue
62	corrective action in accordance with R277-114.]
63	(7) An LEA [may]shall restrict access to survey responses in accordance with
64	the LEA's written policies, Board rule, or state and federal laws.
