

# DUAL LANGUAGE IMMERSION ENDORSEMENT SPECIFICATIONS

This endorsement may be attached to a current Professional or Associate Educator License with an Elementary or Secondary Education area of concentration. This endorsement allows Utah educators to teach Dual Language Immersion in Elementary or Secondary (grades K-12) DLI and Bridge classes. The corequisite World Languages (WL) endorsement qualifies one to teach DLI.
