

TEACHER MENTOR ENDORSEMENT SPECS

PURPOSE:

The endorsement recognizes the efforts and competencies of experienced educators in supporting the retention and professional growth of beginning educators. Those earning this endorsement recognize the importance of providing multiple levels of mentoring support to early career educators and exhibit an understanding of and personal competency within each of the <u>six identified roles of a teacher mentor</u>.

ENDORSEMENT REQUIREMENTS:

Current Utah Professional Educator License
At least one year of full-time employment as an educator in Utah
At least three years of classroom teaching experience
At least three years of effective or higher rating on school/district educator
evaluation, or equivalent

SIX MENTORING REQUIREMENT AREAS:

The Teacher Mentor Endorsement has the following six competency areas:

- 1. Foundations of Mentoring
- 2. Understanding and Building the Mentoring Relationship
- 3. Effective Communication
- 4. Facilitating Beginning Teachers' Growth
- 5. Ongoing Growth as a Professional
- 6. Ongoing Growth as a Mentor
