### Salary Supplement for Highly Needed Educators (SHiNE)

In the 2024 General Session, <u>SB 173</u> created the Salary Supplement for Highly Needed Educators (SHiNE) program. This program will take the place of the Teacher Salary Supplement Program (TSSP) in the 2025-2026 school year. The intent of the bill is to allow individual LEAs to determine which teachers are highly needed in their schools. *A highly needed educator means a teacher who is filling a position that is challenging to fill or retain*. Funds will be allocated to LEAs based on student enrollment count and disbursed to LEAs in 1/12<sup>th</sup> payments.

#### **R277-304 Teacher Preparation Programs**

Here's the updated R277-304 approved by the Board. It delayed the implementation date for General Teacher Preparation Competencies until September 2026 and adopted the Special Education Foundational Competencies with a September 2027. It renames two special education endorsements:

- Old name → New name
- Mild/Moderate Disabilities → Minimal/Moderate Support Needs
- Severe Disabilities → Complex Support Needs
