CACTUS Still Working/Available!

Due to complications in USIMS development, the CACTUS RDS is still available for LEA users. It will remain online and available until further notice. It will likely be available through the winter holiday break.

USIMS Transition Update

Some LEAs will begin beta-testing USIMS in late December. All LEAs will begin using USIMS sometime mid- or late-January. Both USIMS and CACTUS will be offline for a few days prior to the statewide shift to USIMS so we can ensure that USIMS is ready for all LEAs to begin using in late-January. Simplified Route to Secondary

Recent USBE policy updates simplify how some teachers can add the Secondary (6-12) license area to their professional license. Read about the <u>Simplified Route to Secondary</u>. Teachers can apply for the Secondary license area thru Endorsement Only & LER Upgrade applications. We will notify educators who qualify immediately by email.

Earning Additional Content Endorsements by Test

The USBE is working on an implementation plan for the recent policy change that allows professionally licensed teachers to earn additional endorsements through a test. More information will be provided in January.

Online Endorsement Courses Available

New online courses available for <u>English Language Arts and Social Studies endorsements</u> provided by a collaborative effort with USBE, Regional Education Service Agencies (RESAs), and SUU. Salt Lake Community College (SLCC) is offering many <u>teacher education courses</u> for Elementary, Secondary, Special Education Math, Health, and Physical Education.

Educator Shortage Areas (Criticality Index)

The Teacher Teacher Shortage Areas have been approved for the 2024-25 school year that determine TH Bell scholarship areas. The total number of underqualified educators (meaning anything short of Professional licensure/endorsement for assignment) is **down this year to 11.82%.** Last year 13.39% of all educators were underqualified. Elementary education is still the critical shortage area. You may view the 2025 Shortage Areas and 2024 Shortage Areas. Staff believe the success of competency-based licensure, APPEL programs, and decreasing student enrollment contribute to the increase of professionally licensed educators.
