Nationally

Purpose:

Involve youths' voices from the country of Kuwait and the US to establish ways to keep Peace throughout the world.



Sponsored by the Kuwait-America Foundation

Managed by the National Campaign to Stop Violence

Locally

- Sponsored by the Utah State Board of Education and managed by Prevention and Student Services since 2020
- 2025 Challenge:
 - 1,300+ Students
 - 930+ Writings
 - 338 Evaluated by College Students
 - 28 Students Honored

The DtWT Challenge

Answer three questions:



- 1. How has youth violence affected my life?
- 2. What are the causes of youth violence?
- 3. What can my community and I do to reduce youth violence?

Who and What



- Statewide for 7th- and 8th-grade
- students
- Encourages students to make a commitment to take positive steps to change the problem, break the cycle of violence in their home, school, and neighborhood.



Awards & Scholarships

All State Finalists:

- Students' gifts
- Singed certificate from the State Superintendent & the Governor

Scholarships:

- State Finalists: \$300 (2 scholarships per participating school)
- \$400 for two State Runners Up (a boy and a girl)
- \$500 for one National Finalists or "Ambassadors"

National Recognition Summit

- A 5-day trip to Washington DC in the Summer for the ambassador, one parent, and their teacher
- Plus, obligations to State's challenge, including attending the annual Promising Youth Conference, participating as VIP judge for next year's DtWT Challenge, and presenting at next year's DtWT Awards.

2025-2026 DtWT Contest Timeline

- Available: Sept. 2025, at schools.Utah.gov/prevention/dothewritethingchallenge
- Submission Deadline: Friday January 9, 2026
- Review and Selection Process
 - o College students review: Jan. 19-Feb. 20, 2026
 - o a top boy and girl per school will be selected as State Finalists
 - VIP Judges review: March 2nd March 16th, 2026
 - Review top 12 boys and top 12 girls, statewide, to select two runners up and one National Finalists or "Ambassador"
 - Invite finalists to recognition event
- Recognition Event and Award Luncheon: May 1st, 2026 from 11:00 am


