The links for the Certificate of Compliance were distributed on October 1st to all district Superintendents, charter Directors, LEA Board Chairs, and all public school Principals. The Certificate must be completed no later than **October 31st**.



We appreciate all efforts that are being made to submit this information in a timely manner.

On **October 15**th a status update will be provided to all Superintendents, Directors, School Fees Contacts, and Charter Authorizers. This will allow each LEA to work with the individuals still needing to submit the Certificate.

We are currently collecting the Certificate of Compliance submissions and will be reviewing the final data after the October 31st deadline. We are hopeful for a 100% completion rate.

Training Focus:

R277-407-2: (emphasis added)

- (21) "Supplemental Security Income for children with disabilities" or "SSI" means a benefit administered through the Social Security Administration that provides payments for qualified children with <u>disabilities</u> in low income families.
- (22) "Temporary Assistance for Needy Families" or "TANF" means a program, formerly known as AFDC, which provides monthly cash assistance and food stamps to low-income families with children under age 18 through the Utah Department of Workforce Services.

R277-407-11:

- (1) A student is eligible for fee waiver if an LEA receives verification that:
 - (a) in accordance with Subsection 53G-7-504(4), based on the family income levels established by the Superintendent as described in Subsection (2);



- (b) the student to whom the fee applies receives SSI;
- (c) the family receives TANF funding;
- (d) the student is in foster care through the Division of Child and Family Services; or
- (e) the student is in state custody.
- (4) A school may grant a fee waiver to a student, on a case by case basis, who does not qualify for a fee waiver under Subsection (1), but who, because of extenuating circumstances is not reasonably capable of paying the fee.

School Fees Team: What are we doing?

Recently, a survey was sent out to all Business Administrators regarding their LEA's accounting processes. Responses from this survey will be reviewed with the Activity Based Costing work group. This data will allow us to provide information on current accounting practices in our report to the Legislature on activity based costing. The survey will close on October 20th.

At the Public Education Appropriation Committee meeting on October 19th, we will be presenting a preliminary report of USBE's work on activity based costing within the LEAs. The feedback we receive from the survey will allow us to provide more information at the committee meeting.
