Updates to Council Signature Requirement

Background:

This past Fall, the Utah State Board of Education updated its rule requiring council member signatures (R277-477-3). Previously, the form was created and maintained at the state level through the School Land Trust website. Now, districts and charters are required to design and distribute their own signature pages. Signatures may be collected on paper or digitally and copies should be provided to LEA leadership prior to approving the School LAND Trust Plans. This revised rule should allow for greater flexiblilty and a more meaningful, local process for parents to provide LEAs with feedback.

Council Signature Requirements:

The Council Signature Form must be:

- An LEA Prepared Form
- Collected at Council Plan Approval Meeting (or after)
- Provided to approving entity (District School Board or Charter Governing Board) before Board Plan Approval Meeting
- · Kept for at least three years

Sample Language for an LEA created form:

- Provide a paper form that principals can print and have parents sign at a council meeting
- Have principals scan and upload signature pages to their plans on the School Land Trust site
